**THIRD AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER**

This case comes before the court on the parties' joint motion to amend the scheduling order<sup>1</sup> previously entered in this case and joint motion for extension of time for defendants to file a motion to compel (**doc. 147**).

For good cause shown, the scheduling order in this case is hereby amended as summarized in the following table:

Although the parties did not request that the trial date be moved, the trial setting was adjusted to allow the presiding U.S. District Judge, Hon. Eric F. Melgren, adequate time to evaluate any dispositive motions under this third amended scheduling order. All other provisions of the previous scheduling orders shall remain in effect. The schedule adopted in this third amended scheduling order shall not be modified except by leave of court upon a showing of good cause.

The parties have also jointly requested an extension of time for defendants to file a motion to compel. Accordingly, defendants shall have until June 30, 2010, to file a motion to compel relating to plaintiffs' response to defendants' second set of requests for production directed to all named putative class and sub-class representatives.

A copy of this order shall be served by the clerk on all counsel of record.
